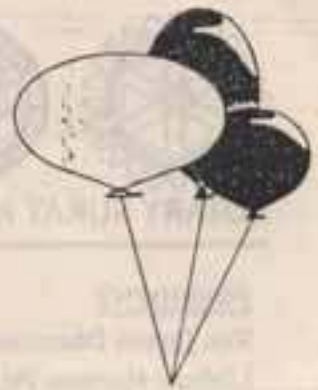

In our continued series 'LET'S KNOW OUR FOUNDER PAUL HARRIS'

1903

Paul visited his boyhood scences in Vermont and became aware of his lack of close friends in his adopted hometown of Chicago. Back in Chicago, he visited the home of a professional friend in the autumn and following a walk in which he was introduced to various merchants in the neighborhood area, Paul conceived the idea of a businessmen's club that could recapture some of the friendly spirit among businessmen in small communities. He made no attempt, however, to put his idea into practice until five years later.

Paul met three young business acquaintances- Silvester Schield, Gustavus Loehr, and Hiram Shorey-in Loehr's office and explained his idea of a different kind of businessmen's club, one in which the various businesses and professions of a community are represented. Rotary was born from this meeting on 23 February.
