We thank all, who made this evening, truly memorable one for spending their valuable time with us and giving inspiration and strength.

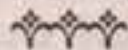
The meeting adjourned by new Sgt.-At-Arms Rtn. Manoj Patel after the song for the Nation, the National Anthem.

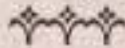
