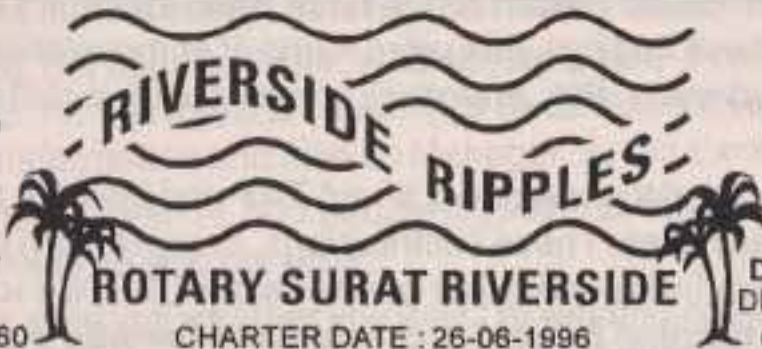

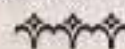

## KNOW MORE :

### **How does a Chordless Remote Control work**

A TV Remote Control works Through Infra-Red Radiation. A Train of pulses is generated in the unit when a button is pressed. These pulses are passed through Infra-Red light emitting diodes (IR-LED). An IR Receiver at the T.V. set converts these pulses and activates the desired function. As every button activates a pre determined train of pulses, the detector can discriminate between the two signals.

As the signals are light waves in the invisible range (Infra - red), like light waves, these get blocked by obstacles in the path reflect by mirror or bounce by other objects. Because of this the remote control sometimes work even if not pointed towards TV.

Unlike Infra-Red, Radio remote control can work through solid walls and obstacles. Radio Remote control can work beyond sight whereas IR Remote control works only in 'Line of Sight'. Radio RC is used in flying model planes, Remote control in Industries for hazardous work Etc.

Both technologies are used these days to suit the application. A chordless Radio Headphone is more useful to listen music while Roaming around the house whereas an IR headphone is suitable to listen while watching the TV or listening to music sitting in the same room where the IR transmitter is present.
