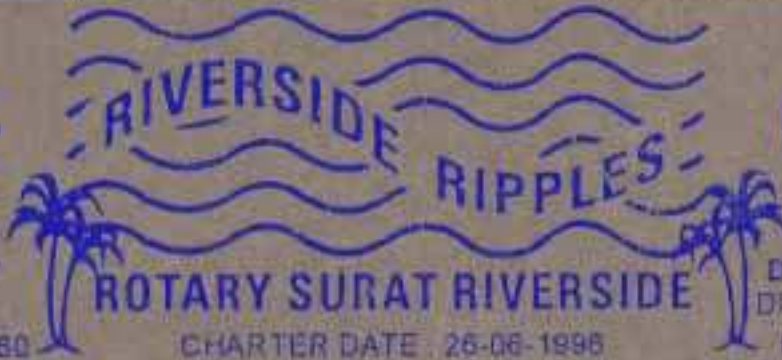

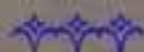

The foundation traces back to 1917. In 1947, Paul P. Harris, the founder of Rotary, died. That year marked the launching of The Rotary Foundation Fellowship Program.
