MEMORIES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The whole of the past week was a busy one discussing the aftershocks of the terrorist attacks on America & its consequences, its effect on the world, to India, Pakistan, the economy & business. The Rotary meeting on Tuesday did give a break from such repeated talks heard & discussed all round you. And what more would you ask as a subject to divert your mind from terrorism to your own health, on which the guest speaker of the evening Dr. Shailendra Vajpeyee spoke on "**Hypertension, perceptions & facts**".

Rtn Dr Ajay Bhardwaj, introduced the guest Dr Vajpeyee, born on the 1st January 1951, obtained his medical education from Gwalior, Rewa {M.P.} Later joined as the Professor & Head of the Dept of Pharmacology at the Govt Medical College Surat. He is currently holding the post of The Medical Superintendent at the New Civil Hospital Surat. He provided exemplary services during Plague epidemic that struck Surat a few years back.

Dr Vajpeyee, I should say is a very calm & relaxed orator. He spoke very briefly on blood pressure, hypertension, its types, its consequences & effects, tests required, controls, remedies, drugs & the latest technology available. He also distributed booklets "**Live Cheerfully Even With Hypertension**". This word hypertension is relatively a very common word used, but for the first time a detailed information was provided on this subject by Dr. Vajpeyee. His simple language explaining the disease proved to be very informative for a layman to understand. Rtn Divyang Parekh, thanked the speaker for his advice, the information, clarifying wrong notions & misconceptions about the disease that he passed on to the members.
