The Friendship scheme was released by District TRF Chairman PDG C. B. Desai at District Assembly. The entire District should become "Friend of Foundation". FRIENDSHIP SCHEME

1. Any one can contribute Rs. 1000/- and become a "Friend of TRF". A special lapel pin will be awarded.
2. In a club, if 10 persons become Friends of TRF there will be a draw. In the draw one person will get a prize of about Rs. 400/- to 500/-.
3. The draw will be repeated only on 20 persons becoming friends of TRF from the same club. The draw will be restricted to contributor No. 11 to 20 only.
4. The draw will be repeated after every 10 more contributors i.e. 30, 40 and so on.
5. After every 10 contributors if any of them is ready to contribute Rs. 2500/-, he will become TRF Sustaining Member.
6. Four persons can be made TRFSM. In case there are more than four persons, who are ready to become TRFSM, there will be a draw.
7. In case there are less than four persons showing readiness to contribute Rs. 2500/-, any non-contributor can also take part, but he will have to contribute Rs. 3500/-.
8. At the end of the year there will be a bumper draw for all contributors in which two persons will be made TRFSM.
9. All members of the club becoming friends of TRF, the club will get a special recognition from the DG.
10. The club becoming Friend of TRF before the District Conference, the club will get two banners from the DG. The club will display one in their meeting hall and one will be displayed in the conference.
