Previous Meet [The D.G. Visit] DL 5th September Wednesday

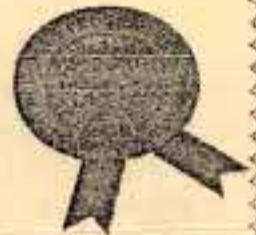

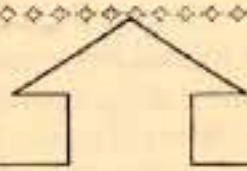

Bhichai Rattakul, of Rotary Club of Dhonburi, Bangkok, Thailand, is the RI President Elect of Rotary International for the year 2002-2003.

A nine-term former Member of the Parliament of Thailand, Rattakul has been a political party leader, Foreign Minister, Deputy Prime Minister, Chairman of the House Foreign Affairs Committee, Vice-Chairman of the National Security Council, and the Narcotics Control Board. Before entering Government, he was President of the Thai Pharmaceuticals Manufacturing Association and Director of the Thai Chamber of Commerce and the Federation of Thai Industries.

A charter member of the Dhonburi club in 1958, Rattakul has served RI as District Governor, International Assembly Discussion Leader, committee member and chairman, Foundation Trustee, and the Board. Currently, he is the Chairman of the 200-01 Diplomatic Relations Task Force. He is ably supported by his spouse Choraye.
