Ophthalmic, Hypertension and Diabetes Camp for the entire Traffic Police force of Surat city

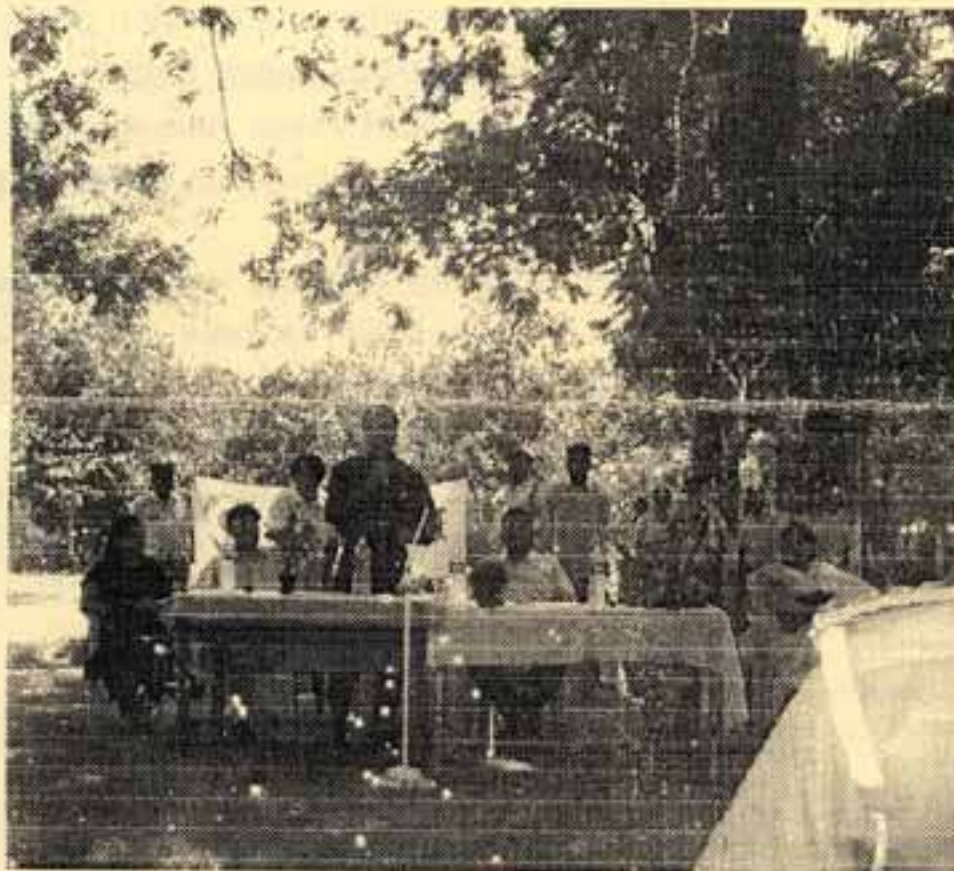
As we are nearing the end of our Rotary year, once again the Riversiders got together for Vocational Services to society.
