On 9 September 02, the RI Nominating Committee selected Glenn E. Estess Sr., of the Rotary Club of Shades Valley, Ala., USA, as president of Rotary International in 2004-05. Estess will lead the RI Convention in 2005, when Rotary celebrates its centennial. He will become the official nominee on 1 December.

Estess is the chairman of the Membership Development and Retention Committee. He served as RI Vice President in 1991-92, RI director, Rotary Foundation trustee, Governor of District 6860, and chairman of Audit and Operations review Committee. He has been a Rotarian since 1960.

He has retired from Glenn Estess Associates, where he was chief Executive officer. Estess was born in Pike County, Miss., USA, and graduated with a bachelor's degree in chemistry from Tulane University in New Orleans.
