# Polio Update as on 9th May 2008

6 cases are reported in 2008 all P3 (4 from Bihar and 2 from U.P).

The total polio case count in 2008 is 222 (P1-4, P1+P3-0 and P3-218).

NO new case reported this week for 2007.

Total polio case count in 2007 is 872 (P1-80, P1+P3-3 and P3-789).

The status of Polio cases is as under:

**Year 2004 = 134 wild Polio cases**

**Year 2005 = 66 wild Polio cases**

Year 2006 = 676 wild Polio cases

Year 2007 = 872 wild Polio cases for the year 2007 (as on May 02, 2008 from 99 Revenue Districts)

Year 2008 = 222 wild Polio cases for the year 2008 (as on May 08, 2008 from 54 Revenue Districts)

The RI District wise and the state wise break-ups are attached.
