Secretarial Report

Vesu Gram Panchayat School:- This year ,we distributed 100 Rain Coats, 300 Sweaters, 40 School Benches. 15 New Ceiling Fans were donated by PP. Mukundbhai, 50 School Bags by PE. Amit Adhiya, aquaguard water filtration plant by Rtn. Asutosh . A Midday meal was also sponsored by the club (Sweets donated by Rtn. Divyesh Gandhi) for the students of the school. 2000 Note books were distributed in the presence IAS officer Ms. Sandhyaben from Gandhinagar and ICDS officer Ms. Alpnaben of zilla Panchayat Surat.
